

Updated Covid Protocols 9/07/22

1. The Hebrew Center will make use of outdoor spaces as much as possible so we can be together in a mask optional setting. Our High Holiday services and Hanukkah services are in the Tabernacle, and we have purchased a tent for Shabbat services and children's activities.
2. When events are indoors, there is a mandatory mask requirement. There is a limit of 50 people in the sanctuary and 75 people when the divider is open.
3. Vaccines and boosters are strongly encouraged but not required at this time.
4. We ask people not to join in person events with any cold-like symptoms including cough, congestion or fever.
5. We will continue to provide internet access to many of our services and classes to maximize participation for everyone.
6. These protocols will be updated as necessary and may change, depending on the emergence of variants, surges, and research data emerging from ongoing public health studies.
